The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m.

Ray Kelleher moved to approve the May 26, 2011 minutes and Mark Roberge seconded it. Minutes approved.

Ron Edgar gave an update of the changes to Spokane Clean Air's new Source Review Regulations. The EPA requires each Agency to submit a State Implementation Plan (SIP) for complying with the Federal Clean Air Act. The SIP consists of rules, technical documentation and agreements that an individual state will use to clean up polluted areas. The SIP provides for implementation, maintenance, and enforcement of the primary and secondary National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) established by EPA under Title I of the Clean Air Act. Ron gave handouts on the changes Spokane Clean is presently working on. Each SIP revision submitted by the state must undergo reasonable notice and a public hearing at the state level. Also, SIP's submitted to EPA to attain or maintain the NAAQS must include enforceable emission limitations and other control measures, schedules and timetables for compliance. The final steps will involve a review by EPA and the Department of Ecology, local Public comment period, adoption by the Board of Directors and EPA's approval. There was some discussion between the Advisory Council and staff.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 a.m.
