RE: Notification of Compliance Status

In March 2007, Spokane Regional Clean Air Agency (Spokane Clean Air) mailed a letter to all Dry Cleaning Facilities highlighting the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) added requirements for all drycleaners who use the chemical perchloroethylene (perc or PCE) as a dry cleaning solvent.

Your facility must be in compliance with these additional requirements by July 28, 2008:

1. **Pressure and Temperature Monitoring** – If a dry cleaning machine is equipped with a pressure gauge on the registration system, the operator must monitor and record the high and low pressure during the drying phase once per week. If a machine does not have the pressure gauge, you must continue monitoring and recording the refrigerated condenser inlet and outlet temperature.
2. **Monthly Leak Inspections** – Dry cleaners must conduct monthly inspections for vapor leaks using a halogenated hydrocarbon detector or a perc gas analyzer (such as a photo ionization detector or PID), while the dry cleaning system is operating. Turn the monitor on in fresh air (i.e. away from the machine, perc storage, building vents, etc.) to accurately calibrate the machine. The new monthly inspection with a monitor shall satisfy one of Spokane Clean Air's weekly inspection for perceptible leaks requirements.
3. **Notification of Compliance Status** – You must submit Notification of Compliance Status to Spokane Clean Air. Please complete the enclosed form and send to the address listed below by registered mail. The completed form must be received by Spokane Clean Air no later than July 28, 2008.

Notification of Compliance Status
