



## **Air Quality Compliance Assistance and Pollution Prevention**

### **Background**

The Spokane Regional Clean Air Agency (Spokane Clean Air) is the primary agency responsible for regulating air pollution from stationary sources in Spokane County. Spokane Clean Air enforces regulations on asbestos, dust, open burning, wood heating, and air emissions from industrial and commercial sources. The agency registers and inspects more than 625 commercial and industrial facilities located throughout Spokane County.

Businesses and industries have reduced air pollution by using improved control technology, thereby contributing to the area's significant air quality improvements.

Spokane Clean Air's regulations, policies and programs are designed to maintain air quality standards today and for many years to come.

### **Compliance Assistance Program**

If you are in business, chances are you deal with many public agencies. Spokane Clean Air's Compliance Assistance Program (CAP) is designed to promote the understanding of air quality regulations among specific business sectors in order to increase compliance and reduce air contaminants.

A series of information sheets, newsletters, and resource guides has been developed to help businesses prevent and control air pollution. In addition, Spokane Clean Air staff is available to provide businesses with one-on-one technical assistance.

### **Pollution Prevention**

Business may also participate in a free pollution prevention consultation. The consultation assists the business owner/operator in understanding their air pollution control equipment, permitting requirements and opportunities to further reduce air emissions.

Benefits associated with reducing air emissions include reduced operating costs and liability, increased productivity, and improved company image.
