Fire Training (Regulation I, Article VI, Section 6.01.G.2).

The following requirements and allowances are effective May 1, 2009.

- **Fire Extinguisher Training Fires** are allowed by general rule pursuant to SRCAA Regulation I, Section 6.01.H.
- **Structural Fire Training Fires** are allowed by general rule pursuant to SRCAA Regulation I, Section 6.01.I.1.
- **Aircraft Crash Rescue Training Fires** are allowed by general rule pursuant to SRCAA Regulation I, Section 6.01.I.2. Specific requirements are specified in RCW 70.94.650(5).
- **Forest Fire Training Fires** consisting of only natural vegetation are allowed without a permit pursuant WAC 173-425-060(2)(f) if conducted pursuant to WAC 173-425-050.

For fire fighting instruction fires not listed above, you may request a written permit valid for up to one calendar year by completing and submitting this application to Spokane Clean Air (Section 6.01.F&G).

- The application fee is \$0 (WAC 173-425-060(3) & Section 10.13).
- The burning of prohibited materials may be restricted or prohibited by SRCAA (WAC 173-425-050(1)(b)).

Instructions

Complete the attached application. Spokane Clean Air can not process your request to burn until a completed application is received. Any inaccurate information or omissions on this application and/or failure to submit required attachments, including the fee, may result in denial of the permit. If you have any questions contact Derek Aubrey at 477-4727 ext. 120. Before submitting your application, make sure you do the following:

1. Provide all requested information.
2. Sign and date the application. *The application must be completed and signed; otherwise, your application will be considered incomplete.*
