



# Spokane Regional Clean Air Agency (SRCAA) FACT SHEET

FOR COVERAGE UNDER THE PORTABLE AUTOBODY SURFACE COATING  
OPERATIONS (PASCO)  
GENERAL ORDER OF APPROVAL (GOA)  
DATED JUNE 21, 2005

1. Coverage under the GOA is automatically in effect the 31<sup>st</sup> day after the submittal of a **complete application**, unless SRCAA issues a postmarked letter within 30 days of receipt of the application denying coverage under the GOA and explaining the reason(s) for the denial.
2. After 30 days, check SRCAA's website ([www.spokanecleanair.org](http://www.spokanecleanair.org)) to see if your business has been added to the list of those businesses covered under the PASCO GOA.
3. Coverage under the GOA does not relieve the applicant or owner of any requirement of any other governmental agency.
4. The equipment must be operated in accordance with the conditions in the PASCO GOA adopted by SRCAA dated June 21, 2005.

## APPEAL RIGHTS

Pursuant to SRCAA Regulation I, Section 5.14 and RCW 43.21B.310, denial of coverage under the PASCO GOA dated June 21, 2005 may be appealed to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB). To appeal to the PCHB, a written notice of appeal must be filed with the PCHB and a copy served upon SRCAA within 30 days of the mailing date of this document. Send your appeal to:
